We also provide them with clean used clothing, blankets, hygiene items, snack bags, & pet foods when we have them available. Items listed below are items that we need on a regular basis for the homeless community. If you are local to us, and want to purchase items, winter items such as heavy socks, knit cap beanies, and gloves can be purchased at Any Dollar Tree Store for \$1.25 each. Very affordable!! We can arrange pickup for you when you are ready. If you are not local, you can also order items from our Amazon Wishlist and it will ship directly to us.

Winter Items Needed Immediately Clothing needs to be in good clean condition for men and women, no children's please. No high heels or flipflops. Tennis shoes/work or winter boots work best as the homeless tend to travel by foot.

Food/snack items/dinnerware – Small /individual food easy to open. Items that do not require refrigeration. Soft foods work well as some have Dental Problems. Below is a list of what we generally put in their snack bags for when they are between meals. Flip Top/Pop Tops cans are best.

(cats and dogs) of the homeless communities as they need care as well. If you are local to us, we will accept any new or opened bags of pet food, dry kibble or sealed canned food.
