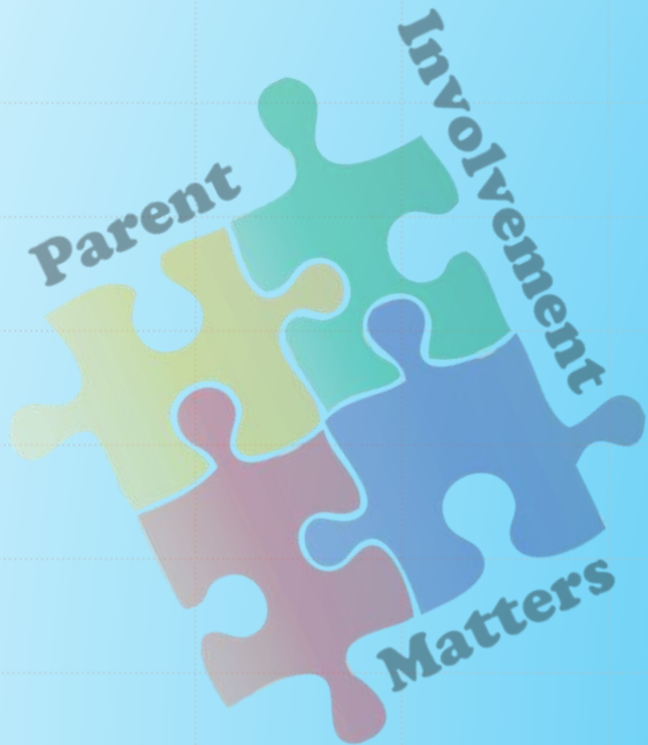

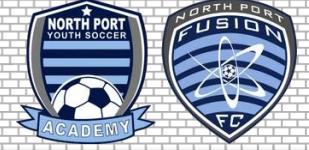


Engage with the local community through outreach to help promote inclusivity and participation in soccer.

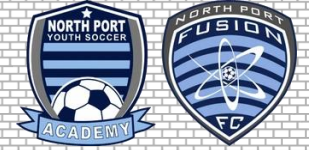
Fusion Parents Engagements

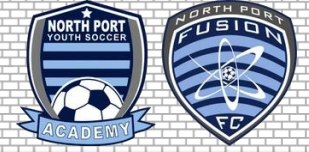

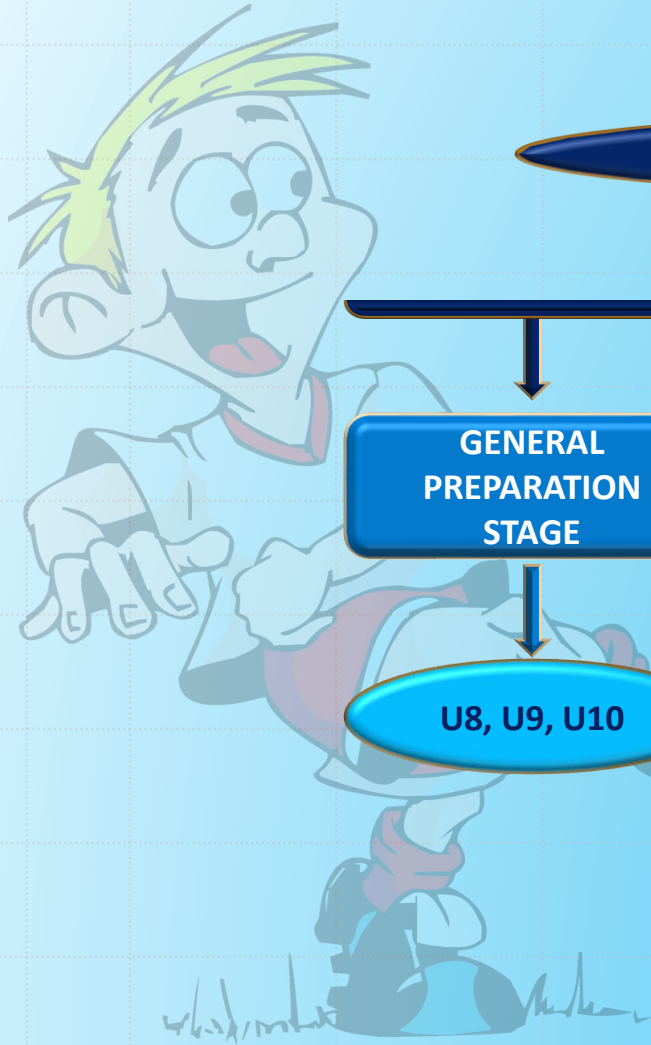

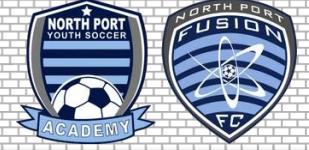

COMMUNICATIONS STRATEGY

Methods and frequency of communication with parents (meetings, emails, newsletters, etc.), platforms or tools to facilitate effective communication.

4

INFORMATION SHARING

Topics to be communicated to parents (player progress, upcoming events, team performance, etc.), how and when information will be shared with parents.

**SIGNING DAY
(JUNE)**

The Club officials present Club`s mission, values and philosophy.

**PRE-SEASON
(JULY/AUG)**

The coach of each team set expectations, responsibility and logistic.

**MID-SEASON
(DECEMBER)**

The coach of each team reviews the interim season results; making plans for the second half of the season, evaluating the outcomes of the first half.

**COACHES
EVAL.
(MARCH)**

The parents participate in the club's quiz, evaluating the head coach, assistant, and trainers.

**POST SEASON
(APRIL)**

Season summaries. Plans for the next season and celebration of the end of current season.
