Irving Oil Aviation Scholarship 2024



The New Brunswick Aviation Museum (NBAM) is proud to announce a scholarship program for New Brunswick students entering the first or second year of an aviation or aerospace related course at an approved college or university. Applicants must be interested in pursuing a career in the aviation and/or aerospace sectors.

Thanks to a generous donation from our partners at Irving Oil, we will award two (2) \$2,500 scholarships in 2024. The NBAM and Irving Oil understand the importance of education and training for those entering this challenging field. This scholarship program is designed to assist deserving students with their post-secondary education.

AWARD

The *NBAM-Irving Oil Aviation Scholarships* enable students to pursue a post-secondary education leading to excellence within the aviation or aerospace sector. This year, NBAM will award **\$2,500.00** scholarships to two students to offset post-secondary education expenses and encourage further education in the aviation or aerospace sector.

FIELD OF STUDY

Successful candidates **must** be pursuing a recognized post-secondary college or undergraduate program of study relevant to the aviation or aerospace sector.

DURATION

For each of the next four years, NBAM will offer 2 x \$2,500.00 *Irving Oil Aviation Scholarships*. The scholarships will be awarded annually based on performance and involvement in the aviation or aerospace sector.

CONDITIONS

All applicants must be enrolled in an approved program or institution in Atlantic Canada. For high school students, proof of acceptance into an approved educational program is required.

DEADLINE

Applications must be received by the NBAM-Irving Oil Aviation Scholarship Selection Committee no later than **June 14, 2024 at 4:00pm.**

To Apply:

Enclose a brief (300-500 word) essay, entitled “Why I want to pursue a career in the aviation and/or aerospace sector,” indicating your academic and career interests, including your plans for achieving them, and why you have chosen to pursue aviation/aerospace as a career.

With this application form, please provide:

1. Most recent transcript of grades
2. *Portfolio, including a resume
3. Two letters of reference

Final selection of the candidates may include a personal interview.

*Portfolio

A collection that includes, but is not limited to, copies of schoolwork, report cards, letter of reference, and participation and/or completion certificates. The collection is presented as a means to enhance the committee’s understanding of your strengths, skills, and achievements.

****NOTE – The NBAM-Irving Oil Scholarship Award winner cheques will be issued and mail out in August before to the start of the school year. The winners will be announced in June 2024.**
