Overall Application Directions: Due Date is April 1.

- 1. Each **eligible** entry is rated using a **blind review judging process**, ensuring a fair and impartial quality assessment. This process involves keeping the applicant's name anonymous by blocking out any identifying data on the materials. <u>In Sections 2 and 3</u>, the anonymous review requires the applicant **not to include their or their parents' names** in their answers.
- 2. The **entire form** must be **completed** and **handwritten** according to <u>each section's directions</u>. The answers to <u>Sections 2 and 3</u> are to be <u>written on separate numbered papers</u>, with <u>each question copied</u>, <u>numbered</u>, and <u>attached</u> to the application.
- **3.** Your research may use artificial intelligence (AI). All responses are to reflect <u>your original</u> thoughts unless properly cited. The answers will be checked for plagiarism and AI-enhanced writing. <u>Plagiarized and AI-generated answers can lead to point deductions</u>, sections being excluded, or applicant disqualification.
- 4. When submitting a <u>digital application</u> by email or in person, you must <u>include files with scanned, etc.</u>, copies of the Section 1 form and your Sections 2 and 3 <u>separate papers</u>. A hand-delivered <u>printed application</u> is to be organized <u>in order by sections</u>, and the pages for Sections <u>2 and 3 are attached</u>. Keep the Information Sheet for your files and reference.

- Your response to these questions will be evaluated based on their clarity, originality, and relevance to the agricultural industry. You also earn points using correct grammar, complete sentences, age-appropriate writing, following directions, and neatness.
- Please do not include your or your parent/guardian's names in your answers, as this is a "blind review" judging process to ensure fairness for each applicant.
- Your research may use artificial intelligence (AI). All responses are to reflect <u>your original thoughts</u> unless properly cited. Plagiarized and AI-generated answers can lead to point deductions, sections being excluded, or applicant disqualification.

- 3. How will you use the funds from this grant (buying livestock, pens, etc.)? (10 points)
- 4. What knowledge do you hope to gain by doing this project? (10 points)

Part B: Agricultural Experiences (20 points)

- 1. What livestock shows, clinics, and projects will you participate in this year? (5 points)
- 2. Please list all Junior Florida Cattlemen's Association (JFCA), 4-H, and FFA projects or *related experiences* you have participated in and the number of years you were in each project or activity. (5 points)
- 3. What knowledge have you gained from your JFCA, 4-H, and/or FFA activities or related experiences? (10 points)

- Handwrite a 2-page essay expressing your opinion on the following Essay Prompt: "Why is the beef industry important?" Your response must include your thoughts about each "Beef Industry Issue," not necessarily in the order listed below, as you connect them to your overall opinion in answering the essay's prompt. Be sure to refer to each Issue in some way in your writing, as the judges will rate how well you connect these issues to your overall opinion when answering the prompt.
- Please do not include your or your parent/guardian's names in your essay, as this is a "blind review" judging process to ensure fairness for each applicant.
- Your response to this will be evaluated based on its clarity, originality, and relevance to the agricultural industry. You also earn points using correct grammar, complete sentences, age-appropriate writing, following directions, and neatness.
- Handwrite your 2-page answer on <u>separate papers attached to the application</u> or **copy for your digital files**. Label your pages with the heading "Section 3 Essay," number the pages, and attach your Section 3 pages to the <u>print application</u>. Or, for a digital <u>application</u>, label and organize your files similarly.
