Thank you for your letter requesting the installation of multi-way Stop signs on Allview Lane at Megans Way in the Green Trails Park subdivision. We appreciate your patience during our review and regret the length of time taken to complete it.

The Harris County Engineering Department (HCED) conducted a formal study at the aforementioned location in accordance with the 2011 Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. HCED made a site visit, conducted traffic counts, reviewed the roadway network and crash records. HCED found no visibility restrictions and sight distances exceed design standards. Traffic volumes and intersection crash experience do not meet minimum warrant requirements to warrant multi-way stop control at this intersection. Based on the traffic conditions observed at this location, multi-way stop control is not warranted or recommended at this intersection at this time under their guiding rules.
