Green Trails Pool Rules

Obey the lifeguards. They have the authority to remove from the pool area anyone disobeying the rules or endangering the safety of himself or others. Lifeguards have the final interpretation of the rules.

- 1. All residents must have an access card to enter the pool area. Everyone must sign in, including guests. Only 4 guests per resident card.
- 2. Parents are responsible for their children and guests at all times.
- All children under the age of 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at least 18 years
 of age. All non-swimming children must be within arms length of a parent or guardian at all
 times.
- 4. Proper swim attire required.
- 5. All infants and children not potty trained must be in swim diapers, no regular diapers allowed.
- 6. Changing diapers within 6 feet of the pool is prohibited.
- 7. No running, pushing, dunking or roughhousing permitted.
- 8. Extended breath holding activities are dangerous and prohibited.
- 9. Stay off ropes. Lap lane is to be used for lap swimming only.
- 10. No diving in the shallow end of the pool.
- 11. Diving area: swimmers must be able to swim without assistance to the ladder. No use of life jackets, flotation devices, or goggles may be used while on the diving board. Only one person allowed on the diving board at all times. All swimmers must dive straight out, not to the side of the diving board, and then quickly get out of the deep end at the ladder on either side. No swimming in diving area when diving board is in use.
- 12. All floats must be approved by lifeguard.
- 13. No smoking tobacco, no vaping, glass containers or alcoholic beverages allowed in the pool area.
- 14. No tennis balls, bicycles, skateboards or scooters allowed in the pool area.
- 15. No loud music in the pool area.
- 16. No loud or abusive language will be tolerated.
- 17. A ten (10) minute "safety break" will be called for ten minutes every hour by the lifeguard, with the exception of the last hour before pool closing. During this period, all swimmers must exit all bodies of water.
- 18. Only children 5 years and younger allowed in the baby pool and must be supervised by an adult.
- 19. No pets permitted on the pool premises.
- 20. No one with exposed injuries or wearing bandages in the pool.
- 21. Do not swim if you have been ill with diarrhea within the past two weeks.
- 22. Anyone swimming after hours will be suspended for the remainder of the swim season and trespassing charges will be filed.
- 23. All parties must be booked through the pool company.
