




Tips for Taking Moon Shots

- Scout out locations and interesting foreground subjects (e.g., barns, windmills).
- Check out the apps: Clear Outside, Photographer's Ephemeris, and PhotoPills.
- Take photos before the full moon.
- Use a tripod and remote cable release for best results.
- A good starting point is to use manual mode, f/11, ISO 100 or 200.
- Use spot metering.
- Using a long telephoto lens and shooting during moonrise can make the moon and subject look larger than usually seen.


