Photography Tips

A few tips for architecture photography:

- Use a tripod and try a wide-angle lens. Also consider panoramic shots.
- Look for repeating patterns, symmetry and shapes, and explore a variety of angles.
- Try taking photos of the same building different times of the day, including the blue hour or even different days.
- Check for straight lines pre- and post-processing.
- Zoom in for interesting, intriguing, or unique details.
- Have more in the foreground with less sky.
- Consider capturing an element of the building's history.

These are the categories for the competition:

- 1. Scenic landscapes or cityscapes
- 2. Animals wild or domestic
- 3. Plants any type
- 4. People doing anything, or portraits
- 5. Reptiles, amphibians, or insects
- 6. Birds
- 7. Open ONLY for photos that can't fit in another category
- 8. Creative Obviously manipulated
- 9. B&W or monochrome.

Members can submit up to 6 photos, but only 1 in each category. Submissions are due by April 20th on the Google Docs links sent out by Reed so we can get them to the judges. The photo submission rules are the same as the monthly showcase. Size: 2048 pixels on the longest side. Title your photos: your assigned number-title.jpg.

Photo Submission Rules

(Submit only if you plan to attend the meeting)

- Prepare photos. Name all submissions with your first name + last name and title of the photo. Example. Leslie Larson–Bear.jpg
- 2. <u>Size photos</u>. Resize photos to 2048 pixels on the longer side. Photos no larger than 5MB and in .jpg format.
- Reed will send an email each month with three links. 1) Special topic, 2) Challenge topic, and 3) Open. You may enter only three total photos.
- 4. Enter photos (drag and drop) into the correct SVPS link sent out before the meeting every month. <u>Deadline</u>: 11:30 pm Sunday before the following Monday meeting to send in your submissions. Let Scott know if, for any reason, you don't want your photos to be displayed on our website: go-SVPS.com.
