*** Rules Have Been Updated *** Monthly Photo Showcase Submission Rules

No more than a total of **four** (4) digital images may be entered in the following categories:

- Special Topic of the Month (0-2 images)
- Challenge Topic (0-2 images)
- Open category (0-2 images)
- Creative (no longer a category; combined with Open)

All members are encouraged to enter photographs.

Submit photographs to Visual Pursuits by the Sunday prior to the meeting at 7 pm.

NO late entries. NO digital entries will be accepted at the club meeting.

While changes don't happen often, submit photos each month after receipt of the newsletter in case there are updates to the category topics and related definitions.

File Type: Submit .JPG files only

<u>Maximum digital image file size</u> is 7680 pixels wide x 4320 vertically to allow for the best possible resolution.

<u>Photo Title</u>: The name of the image is all that is required (blank spaces are allowed)

- Photographer's name is no longer required in the photo's title.
- Category Code is no longer required in the photo's title.

<u>Category Code</u>: Images should be placed in the proper Visual Pursuits category. Default is SPEC for Special, and an alert will be triggered if too many images are entered. Please double check the category for each image entered before leaving Visual Pursuits to ensure proper placement.

February's Member Meeting Presentation Photo Critiques

Greg Holden and Charles Needles, two SVPS members will evaluate images submitted by members at the February 1, 2021 online member meeting.

Charles Needles became a SVPS member last year. Charles is a full-time professional photographer who makes his living exclusively from teaching photography, writing books, and speaking/presenting webinars over the last 20+ years. He has judged and critiqued for many clubs over his career.

Greg Holden is the current SVPS President. Prior to moving to Colorado, Greg was a regular speaker and judge at camera clubs in the MD/VA area. Greg was regularly requested to judge multiple times for clubs, sometimes even a second time in the same year. Greg has been praised for his ability to offer critical feedback without being offensive and sensitivity to tailoring his feedback to both novice and advanced photographers alike.

Photo critiques are set up to allow for evaluation of one photo per photographer. All photos must be entered into Visual Pursuits by Sunday, January 31 at 7 p.m. The title should not include the photographer's name. Maximum file size is 7680 x 4320. Within Visual Pursuits there is a separate Critique category for entering your images for February's Member Meeting program. Photographs entered into the monthly showcase in the Special, Challenge and Open categories will not be critiqued.

Club Competition Projected-Image Division Summary

The Photographic Society of America (PSA) offers individuals and clubs from across the country (and the world) an opportunity to enter photos for judging in a variety of competitions, see <u>https://psa-photo.org/index.php?home</u> for details. Our club is currently participating in the Interclub Competition for the Projected Image Division (PID). Within this division, there are two digital-only Interclub competitions, Open and Creative. These competitions between photo clubs are held three times per year (Nov 15, Feb 15 and April 15), with a Best of Best competition at the end of the year.

Participating clubs are divided into Groups (A thru F), with a maximum of about 25 clubs in each group. We are in Group E. Clubs start in Group F and work their way up as their scores improve. Clubs garner points, based on scoring from judges during the three yearly competitions. The objective is to have clubs with high scores competing against other high scoring clubs. Clubs are re-arranged at the end of the year based on their accumulated scores from the 3 competitions.

Judging of all the photos in a Group is provided by a HOST CLUB, which is a club in another Group, who was selected at the beginning of the year. The HOST CLUB provides 3 judges and each judge scores each photo on a 1 to 5 point scale. So the maximum score a photo can obtain is 15. These judges then select the top 20% of scoring photos in that Group, and award Merit awards to about half of them, and Honorable Mention awards to the remainder. To date our club has only participated in the "Open" competition for which:

...images may be either COLOR or MONOCHROME. The content is unrestricted and may include creative images, with all forms of manipulation permitted. With regard to all entries, the maker must have exposed or created all elements of the final image. All submitted images are judged together and are not separated by Color or Monochrome. The work must be the maker's and commercial clip art is not allowed.

Clubs can submit up to 6 photos for each of the 3 competition rounds, from 6 different photographers. We can't submit 2 or more photos from the same author. Once submitted, a photo can never be re-entered in the Open Interclub competition.

Size restrictions are: Horizontal images will be no more than 1400 pixels wide or 1050 pixels tall. Vertical images will be no more than 1050 pixels tall. Save the file in .jpeg format only. A 4 to 3 image ratio is strongly recommended to assure the best projection of your image for judging. sRGB color space is recommended for optimum results.

PSA Release Forms

The PSA Projected Image Division (PID) Competition Representative for SVPS, Reed James, collects release forms supporting PSA competitions.

What the signed release form accomplishes:

- Required for entering any PSA competition; authorizes the club PSA representative to upload your photo file to the PSA competition site,
- When awarded a PSA Merit or Honorable Mention, gives PSA permission to display your image, allows your photo to be projected on the PSA website, and to move your image forward to an end-of-year competition,
- For both PSA and the club, it guarantees that the work is yours, confirms that you have the necessary model or property release forms, if needed, and confirms that you alone hold the copyrights.
- Signed release forms are valid for three (3) years from the document's date.




SVPS Board Meeting Minutes Summary December 28, 2020 Meeting

- Monthly photo showcase category entries per member have changed:
 - Special 2 entries (increased from 1)
 - Challenge 2 entries (increased from 1)
 - Open will remain at 2 entries and now will include Creative images. The purpose of the Open photo category is to submit photos that don't fit into monthly Special and Challenge categories rather than to submit extra Special and Challenge photos.
 - Creative now included as part of the Open category.
 - Each member will still be able to enter up to 4 images maximum each month.
- The website is currently being reviewed and updated, most recently with meeting presenters for 2021 and links to member's social media. Members should look for more updates moving forward.





A memorial service will be held for Jim via Zoom on January 23, 2021 at 2 p.m. They will start admitting those attending at 1:45 p.m.




