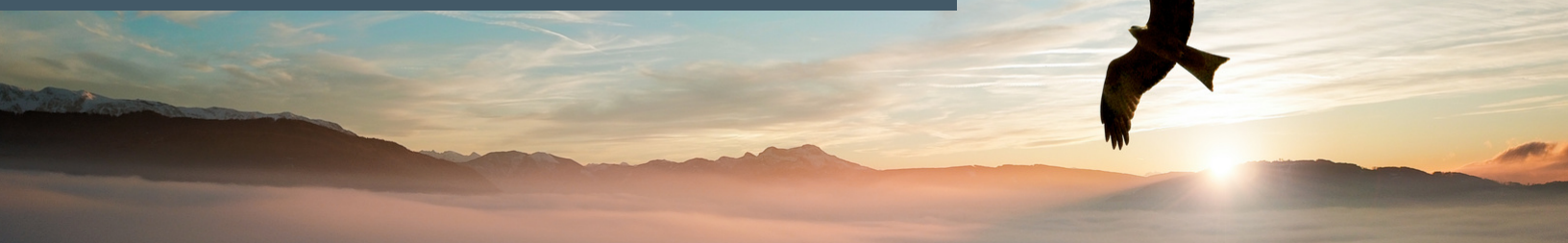

Be prepared at the SHOW/TELL program on March 7th to describe the edits you performed and to share your thought process as you created your image(s).

You may submit one or two images to the special contest called "Creative Photo Challenge" in Visual Pursuits. It will be an additional category beyond the open, special, challenge, and critique categories. All members are encouraged to enter photographs. Photographs must be submitted to Visual Pursuits by 11:30 pm on Sunday, March 6th.

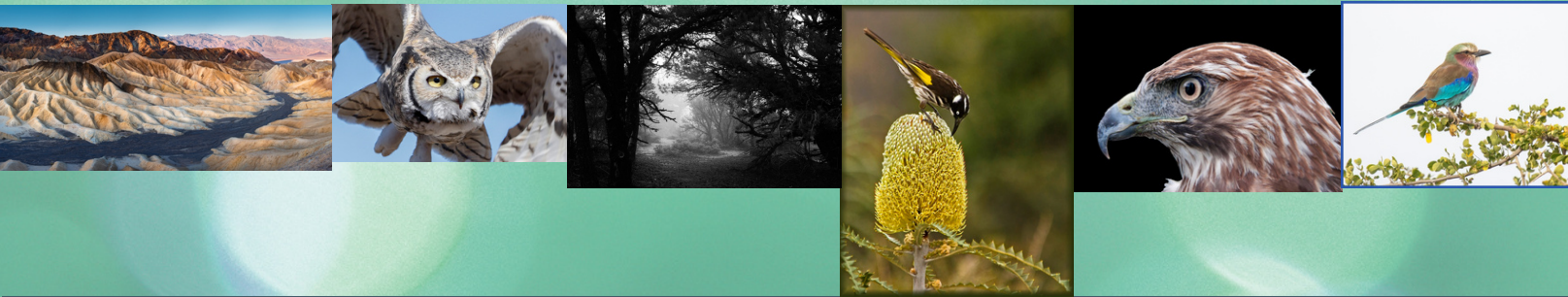


PSA PID ROUND 2 CLUB VOTING RESULTS
