



Let's broaden what we comment on during photo showcase:

- ✓ Composition (e.g., rule of thirds, leading lines, Sshape curves, diagonal lines, negative space)
- ✓ Use of color complimentary, contrasting.
- ✓ Use of light (e.g., sidelight, backlight, ...)
- ✓ What stands out or draws the viewer's eye.
- ✓ Emotional impact
- ✓ How motion or action are captured.
- ✓ How does the photo creates mystery or drama....
- ✓ What detail pops out (e.g., especially with macro).

SVPS CLUB COMPETITION

Our June meeting will be the annual awards banquet. We will cater the basics and hope members will bring sides or desserts. It will be at the church (in a different room at the other end) on June 17th from 6 to 8:30. Set-up begins around 5:00.

These are the categories for the competition:

- 1. Scenic landscapes or cityscapes
- 2. Animals wild or domestic
- 3. Plants any type
- 4. People doing anything, or portraits
- 5. Reptiles, amphibians or insects
- 6. Birds
- 7. Open ONLY for those that can't fit in another category
- 8. Creative Obviously manipulated or B&W or monochrome.

Members can submit up to 6 photos, but only 1 in the chosen category. Submissions due on Visual Pursuits by May 25th so we can get them to an outside judge.

Need to talk about judging options. If we ask PSA judges to do it there will be no feedback, only the scores. They can't take the time to give feedback on the number of entries we send in. We can find a local photographer who isn't familiar with members to do the judging. We would pay for the time including the extra time to make comments.



Field trips: Will most likely be during the summer months. If the hummingbird population warrants it this season, Leslie will have a hummer shoot sometime in later June. Cathy will lead a flower session; time and date TBA. Field trip updates will be sent out by SVPS email when definite dates and times are available. Anyone wanting to lead or organize a trip, let Leslie know. Trips can be more than one day - perhaps one to Paint Mines Park near Colorado Springs.
