

Tips for taking unusual subjects or intimate lighting


- Use your perspective to create a unique composition, lighting, angles, or backgrounds.
- Try different lenses such as macro or wide-angle.
- Look for the out-of-the-ordinary or unexpected.
- Pay attention and accentuate small details.
- Make everyday objects or scenes look uncommon.
- Capture the perspective of the subject.
- Convey stillness, tranquility, solitude.
- Try different ways of processing e.g. adding texture, converting to black and white.
