


Introduction




Model Complex Sentence

I see a couple of surfers, who make me feel energetic.

Model Complex-Compound Sentence

I see a <u>couple of surfers</u>, <u>who</u> make me feel <u>energetic</u> <u>because</u> they remind me of <u>surfing in the Dominican Republic</u>.

 - At least 1 relative clause.


