**EVERY TEAM NEEDS A COACH—GOD BLESS FATHERS WHO ARE
FOLLOWING BIBLICAL PRINCIPLES**

IT IS SAID: “The LOVE of a Father for his children is more than provision and protection, leadership and guidance—it is part of who we are, what we become, and the way we serve the Lord with our lives. It is a strong and binding cord that runs through the fabric of our character...”

TEXT: Ephesians 6:1-4 v.4 And ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath, but bring them up in the NURTURE and ADMONITION of the Lord.

INTR- Our Lord is looking for fathers today that are truly interested fulfilling the father’s role in the family expecting Him to bless them. Today we will look at **FOUR THINGS** that we as PARENTS should do to be successful in the sight of the Lord.

- 1- To be obedient to the Lord as parents **WE MUST EMBRACE THE PRIORITY OF PARENTING** v4. and ye fathers...bring them up “
 - The absentee dad is the most harmful demographic trend affecting our society
 - Today I want to commend many of you dads for your vision of being a great dad....We are the coaches to our family..
 - Stu Webber...”The highest office in the land is not in the White House. It is in your house”.

2. To obey the Lord as a parent **WE MUST BE WILLING TO USE VERBAL and HANDS on NUTURING and ADMONITION (Correction)**
 - Verbal correction is good but it is not a substitute for hands on correction which includes spanking but not limited to spanking.
 - Correction should be administered God’s way
 - (1) EARLY – Prov. 19:8- “discipline while there is hope”
 - (2) CONSISTENTLY –Prov. 23:13..do not hold back discipline
 - (3) PAINFULLY – Heb. 12:11 No discipline seems enjoyable at the time, but painful
 - (4) LOVINGLY – Rev 3:19 the Lord disciplines those He loves

3. To be Godly Fathers we must **ENGAGE THE PROCESS** of leading our children....We must answer our calling as Dads
 - Parenting is always “current and ongoing”- the verb translated “bring them up” is present active tense
 - Let us always be faithful to our calling as Dads and MOMS

4. To be a PARENT that God wants to use...**EXPECT PROGRESS-** by faith we trust God to work in the hearts of our children.
 - Parenting is ongoing but it is also **GOING IN A POSITIVE DIRECTION!**
 - Jim Elliot...”Where ever you are, be all there” (Eccl. 9:10)
