1. MAKE SURE YOU TRUST IN GOD ...2 Cor. 1:3 Bless be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies..

2. MAKE SURE YOU KNOW GOD...that is you know His character...1 Cor.1:3 the Father of mercies and the God of all comfort

- **He is the provider of all that is good...He alone is the source of good...He is the source of encouragement, comfort, mercy**

3. REMEMBER THE COMFORTS OF THE PAST v.4 Who comforteth us in ALL our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them, which are in any trouble

4. RECOGNIZE OUR RESPONSIBILITY...v.4 that we may be able to comfort others

*** Let us not live in defeat...let us let God work through us to bless others**

5. REST IN THE PROMISES OF GOD v. 5 For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so our consolation also aboundeth by Christ.

*** God today wants to share with you and Comfort you...He is for you**
