

Lap robes are basically a 4' x 6' quilt. These should be fairly heavy.

The objective of the lap robes is to stop air so denim with no batting, fleece with no batting or cotton with batting in the middle or cotton with denim on the other side and no batting all work. These robes can not be crocheted as they can not have a lot of loops which would catch on things and there may be a problem with air movement.

They are using blue jeans cut into about 4" strips and tacked onto each other. Any jeans will work for this but anything smaller than a child's size 7 is considered too small.

Catheter bags can be made of cotton

Walker totes need to use a heavier material.

Cotton is used for catheter bags

Heavier material for walker totes -

Very heavy for lap robes – can also use cotton but will need batting in the middle

Fleece can be used for any
