Only users that have been added to the server will have access to the server. This would greatly increase your protection against a potential threat to the network.

Backup Solution: Included in this server package is software for performing local backups. This server will be configured to write on 2 disks. In case of another hard drive failure, a backup would be on hand. Also included is a 3<sup>rd</sup> hard drive for local user backups. This would offer redundancy to the upgraded IDrive account and offer a local backup in case of another hardware failure.

Repurpose existing server: Windows 10 is end of life next year and we could repurpose the old server as a workstation to upgrade to windows 11.
