Below I have outlined the proposed updated scope of work, project totals, and some notes to take into consideration.

- remove and replace three windows (38" x 68") and one exterior door w/ brick molding (30" x 80") on front of house in living room area, siding will need to be removed and reinstalled
 - remove and replace one exterior door w/ brick molding (32" x 80") plus new storm door (white) on back porch (north), siding will need to be removed to install and white J channel installed
 - remove and replace both existing kitchen windows with large casement window (64" x 36"), siding will need to be removed to install new construction windows w/ built in J channel
 - remove and replace one exterior door (32" x 80") plus new storm door (white) on east side porch, remove and replace one window (32" x 64"), siding may need to be partially removed to install white J-channel up to new brick molding
 - remove existing and install seven new construction windows on 2nd floor of home with built in J channel (approximately 28" x 45"), siding will need to be removed to reinstall siding behind J
 - remove existing and install two new construction windows in dining room of home with built in J channel (approximately 30" x 52"), siding will need to be removed to reinstall siding behind J
 - remove existing and install one new construction window in utility room of home with built in J channel (approximately 33" x 28"), siding will need to be removed to reinstall siding behind J
 - remove existing and install one new construction window in bedroom of home with built in J channel (approximately 40" x 26"), siding will need to be removed to reinstall siding behind J
 - remove existing and install one new exterior door for basement with brick molding trim (approximately 42" x 74"), siding will need to be removed to install new J channel up to brick molding
- * All windows to be new construction with nail fins, white, double hung, half screen, argon, built in J channel, no grids

I believe this covers our bases and brings us quite close to a real cost to this project. Some of the window measurements I have not had a chance to measure to verify accuracy and will need to make a final trip over to the house should this project move forward. 
