TOPIC: PUBLIC HEARING: EL RANCHO CHARTER SCHOOL 2026-2027 LOCAL CONTROL AND ACCOUNTABILITY PLAN

DESCRIPTION: The Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP):

- The Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) requires LEAs to engage their local educational partners in an annual planning process to evaluate their progress within eight state priority areas encompassing all statutory metrics. These results are documented in the LCAP.
- Based on performance across the state priorities and on indicators in the California School Dashboard, the LCAP demonstrates how budgetary resources are responding to student and community needs, addressing performance gaps and meeting our obligation to increase and/or improve services for foster youth, English learners and low-income students.
- El Rancho Charter School has chosen 4 Goals to address: Math, English, Social and Emotional Learning and Learning Recovery Performing Emergency Block Grant (LREBG)
- The development process serves three distinct, but related functions:
 - Comprehensive Strategic Planning
 - Meaningful Educational Partner Engagement
 - Accountability and Compliance

FISCAL IMPACT: \$771,708

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Charter Board of Education hold a public hearing and receive public comment on the 2026-2027 Local Control and Accountability Plan.
