

## 1.1 LESSON 5.2 UNDERSTANDING MY IEP

An IEP is an Individualized Education Plan or Program that is developed to ensure that a student who needs special education, receives specialized instruction and services related to their identified disability.

An IEP is developed by a team of educational advocates, the parents and the student to identify the student's academic progress, strengths, goals, and accommodations necessary for the student to be successful.
