

Lesson Title: Employee Benefits

Lesson Overview - students will learn about different types of employee benefits such as health insurance, retirement and PTO as well as the importance of having each.

Vocabulary Terms *terms are covered in module 9.1.3* Medical insurance - insurance that covers a portion of the cost for vision, medical or dental visits or procedures

Life insurance - a policy that pays your family in case of death

Disability - provides income to individuals who can no longer work due to a disability

Retirement Plans - savings or investment plans that are intended to pay for life expenses once an employee retires
