

2019 Riesling Collection Terroirs

AOC Alsace

Delicate aromas and flavors of lemon and verbena delight in this lovely Alsace-born Riesling. The wine's finish is long and satisfying. Crafted from a careful blend of single vineyard terroirs -- consisting of granite, sand and pebbles, limestone and Marl -- the diversity of soils that nurtured these vineyards lends a distinct elegance and minerality on the palate.

Cave de Turckheim: Turckheim's vineyards have long been renowned. The town, which was an imperial city under the Holy Roman Empire, has been exporting its wines throughout Europe since the Middle Ages. Since 1955, Cave de Turckheim winemakers have crafted these grapes into wines with an extraordinary range of qualities and flavors. All our wines are vinified in accordance with the AOC Alsace, AOC Alsace Grand Cru and AOC Crémant d'Alsace.

The Terroir: Turckheim's unique position on two geological fault lines -- those of Munster's valley and the plain of Alsace -- combined with its rich variety of soil types provides an ideal terroir for all the major grape varieties of Alsace to happily thrive.

Vintification: Traditional in stainless steel tank, fermentation temperature 19 degrees C
