Welcome to Julie Rogers Studio of Dance

Class Placement:

All students are placed according to their physical ability and talent, considering the ability to apply and retain technical corrections. Class placement is determined during evaluations by teachers.

Class Etiquette:

While dance is an art of passion, it is also an art of discipline. This discipline is what makes dance a positive influence on your child's life. Students are required to arrive to classes on time with proper attire. See the dress code section for more information. Please notify the studio if you will be late or missing class.

Dress Code:

All students must wear appropriate dance attire and dance shoes. Hair should be tied back in a ponytail. No jewelry should be worn. We suggest putting your student's name inside of all dance shoes.

Ballet - Solid black, single piece leotard, tan or pink tights and split sole ballet shoes. No skirts. Black sports bras only. Hair must be worn in perfect bun with mousse and gel.

Toddler I & II - Any color leotard and tights or crop top and dance shorts. Bloch Mary Jane tan buckle tap shoes and pink ballet slippers.

Tap - Any color leotard and tights or crop top and dance shorts. Bloch Rhythm Tap tan buckle tap shoes.

Jazz - Any color leotard and tights or crop top and dance shorts. Dance PAWS brand only.

Hip Hop - Jazz clothes or comfortable street clothes with non-marking tennis shoes.

Payment Information:

Tuition - JRSD runs on a ten month schedule from September to June. Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of each month. Payments received after the 10th of the month will incur a 10% late fee. Please direct your billing questions and payment arrangements to our office manager. The office retains the right to collect a \$35 fee for returned checks. The monthly tuition rate will remain the same throughout the year regardless of the number of weeks in any given month. Discounts are not provided for missed classes.

Competition Fees - Competition fees may vary from one competition to another. Due dates for competition fees are firm to ensure that dance troupes are fully enrolled. Late payment of competition fees will result in a 10% late fee and the cost to overnight the payment to the competition.

Costume Deposit - Costume deposits are due by October 15th in the amount of \$65/costume. Remaining costume balance is due by January 15th. All costume fees are non-refundable.
