## **Rules at Eagle City Park**

**Note:** We also have a new 6-person committee to help management with establishing rules and regulations in Eagle City Park. The committee will be points of contact for all Park members and guests. The committee members will take in complaints and suggestions from Park members and guests and make attempts to resolve said complaints and take all suggestions into consideration. A list of the committee members will be posted in the office or outside the office on the wall.

- 1. No Generators, ATVs, Motorcycles, motors or noisy activity after 9:00 PM or DARK, whichever is first.
- 2. No loud music anytime. Not all of us like the same music.
- 3. Motor bikes and ATVs are welcome as long as they are used to travel QUIETLY from one site to another, hauling equipment to and from your work area or driving to and from the Park. Stay on established roads and trails within the Park. We have built a trail across the creek for kids to joy ride on. Please check it out with your kids or grandchildren and encourage them to ride over there and stay on the trails. Pleasure riding shall be done in the national forest, not int the Park. Please, refrain from riding within the Park after 9:00 PM or dark whichever is first. Remember that the Park is near residential sites. Please use common sense while riding/driving in and out of the Park, 5 mph while on Park property.
- 4. Fires are to be small in size and contained within a stone and /or metal ring no larger than 24" in diameter and all burnable items cleared from a 15-foot radius around the fire pit. Watch for overhead limbs. Two buckets of water. Fires are to be **completely out with water** before leaving. Feel free to use any dead trees you find on your site for your fire. Do not cut down live trees unless you have permission from the Park management. **Do not throw bones into the fires.** They do not burn up completely and attract dogs & bears. Overnight guests, Please **DO NOT** put non-burnable items (i.e.: aluminum cans, tin foil, bottle caps, pull tabs, glass, etc.) in the fire pits.
- 5. The discharging of firearms and fireworks within the Park is strictly prohibited.
- 6. The sale, use or possession of illegal drugs will insure banishment from the Park and possible arrest.
- 7. Moderate use of alcohol is allowed; excessive use of alcohol is not.
- 8. If you or your guest smoke, please do not throw your butts on the ground or in the stream. Pick up all wrappers, bottle caps, cans, bottles and take them with you.
- 9. The eagles' nest is for the use of Park members, their guests and family. The Northwest Gold Prospectors Association will also use it for their outings as well as other invited guests. Pick up after yourselves. There are no trashcans. You must pack out your trash.
- 10. The Park is a wonderful place for kids and dogs to run and play, please keep both quiet and under control. Be sure you clean up after them. If your dog(s) don't get along with others, please keep them on a leash or muzzled.
- 11. Do not adventure onto the adjourning private property. The Park boundaries are marked. If you are not sure where the lines are, please ask. We do not like trespassers and neither do our neighbors. We welcome visitors, but do not prospect unless you have made arrangements for payment of the required lease fee/fees. There will be Park representatives who will inquire about these arrangements.
- 12. Do not dig/tunnel into the high bank left by the flood. It is a safety hazard. We will be pulling material down from time to time for you to work.
- 13. Visitors are to Park on the left side of the driveway before the gate. Only Park members and their guests and registered overnight non-members may take vehicles beyond the gate. All guests must register with the office or Park host.
- 14. Pack it in Pack it out! We have no trashcans. Leave the Park in as good or better condition than you found it.

- 15. Although you can keep all the gold you find, please share your success stories and pictures.
- 16. Panning, sluicing, high banking, sniping and metal detecting are allowed. **Dredging is limited to Eagle City Park** members only. No more than a 2 ½ inch nozzle and 2 ½ inch suction hose is allowed. Be sure you have a copy of your current Idaho Small Scale Mining Authorization (Letter Permit) on file at the ECP office. See Park management for details on all the above.
- 17. Do not dump gray water and/ or waste tanks on the ground. This will ban you from the Park, subject you to the cost of cleanup and bring the wrath of the Idaho Panhandle Health Department down upon your shoulders. Shoshone Camp (6 miles up the river) has a dump station. We can also arrange to have your holding tank pumped by our portapotty people.
- 18. Please respect your neighbor's site and do not use it as a shortcut to the creek or as a thoroughfare.
- 19. Keep your site tidy. Keep the grass cut and debris picked up. Do not encroach upon the adjoining site. Give each other some elbowroom.
- 20. There is an abundance of wildlife in the Park. Feel free to watch, but don't disturb them. Instruct your children not to kill frogs, snakes, etc. Tell them... you kill it, you eat it.
- 21. If you use a metal detector, DO NOT use it around someone's equipment or in their claimed area... Common sense....

  DO NOT detect in the main common area, it should be marked with tape... NO detecting in someone else's tailing piles.
- 22. In the event a member or guest(s) violates any of the above, the following will happen. First, you'll receive a verbal warning, 2<sup>nd</sup> time you'll receive a written warning, 3<sup>rd</sup> and final time you'll have a hearing with the committee to decide what the outcome of the violation will be.
- 23. A large coffee maker is located on the back deck of the office. You are welcome to join us each morning to plan each other's day or to help solve the world's problems. If you partake, please contribute a can of coffee, cocoa, creamer, sugar, sweetener, cups, or money occasionally.
- 24. Use common sense in all your actions. This is designed to be a family Park for its members and guests who are interested in the Hobby of Recreational Gold Panning/Small Scale Mining. We are all here to have fun and to enjoy ourselves. Let's help each other to accomplish this and hopefully we can dig up some GOLD in the process.
