PARK MEMBERS ONLY Dredging and High Banking

Common sense dictates that you give your fellow dredger some room to work. Do not put your dredge right next to someone or directly upstream from them.

Stay at least 50 feet apart.

The <u>maximum size</u> of a dredge hose, nozzle, power jet is 2 ½ inch in diameter. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Anything smaller is allowed... anything larger is against the rules.

Only Park members are allowed to dredge and use dry land nozzles.

Dryland or Hydro Force nozzles and hoses are not to exceed 2 ½ inches in diameter.

Again, NO EXCEPTIONS!

All dredgers and high bankers **MUST** have the proper permits before they operate their equipment. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

There will be inspections of all equipment and permits before your operation begins.

A Park member that mines by dredge, high banking, etc., during the summer season has the **option** to **reclaim** his or her spot the **following spring**.

You have until <u>July 4th</u> to reclaim your spot by placing a bucket, marked with your **First & Last Name and Lot Number** on your spot as soon as possible.

After that date the claim is available for others to claim.
