## Visitor rules for prospecting

## Please use common sense...

If it's not yours, **please don't touch**... Do not touch or move any equipment or buckets that's not yours.

If someone is dredging, please **use caution** around that area. Stay back 20 feet, it's OK to watch but **watch out for flying rocks.** They can't see everyone. If you wish to watch someone mine, please let them know you are there. **Common sense** 

Visitors are <u>not allowed</u> to dredge... You may use a high banker, with the following rules... NO dredge hose attached to it, and you need a water rights permit (you can get at the office) and the tailings cannot be returned straight into the stream.

You may use your own equipment, sluice box, gold pan, metal detector, etc., or the office has some equipment to rent if you wish, **please return the equipment** when you are done.

Please do not move in on somebody else's claim. **Common sense**, give some elbow room to work at-least 10 feet from your neighbor. If there is a bucket or equipment set up, please find a different spot to prospect. If you are camping for more than one day you can leave your equipment or a bucket with your name on it in your spot to work the next day.

Pack it in, pack it out... please clean up your area. Take all your trash home.

If you use a metal detector, do not use it around someone's equipment or in their claimed area... **Common sense** says you do not detect in the main common area. It will be marked with tape... no detecting in that area or someone else's tailing piles...

Do not dig/tunnel into the high bank left by the flood. It is a safety hazard.
