

DESSO TERMS, PRIVACY POLICY, AND COMMUNITY GUIDELINES

Welcome to Desso. Before using the app, please read and agree to these Terms, Privacy Policy, and Community Guidelines.

By creating an account, logging in, or using Desso, you agree to follow these rules. If you do not agree, do not use the app.

1. WHAT DESSO IS

Desso is a social app that helps people discover and connect with others nearby.

You are responsible for how you use the app, what you post, and how you interact with other users. You agree to use Desso safely, respectfully, and legally.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- You must be at least 18 years old to use Desso.
- By using Desso, you confirm that you are at least 18 and that the information you provide is accurate.
- We may suspend or remove accounts that violate these Terms or appear to be unsafe, fake, abusive, or ineligible.

3. NO TOLERANCE FOR OBJECTIONABLE CONTENT OR ABUSIVE USERS

Desso has no tolerance for objectionable content or abusive users.

You may not post, upload, share, send, or promote content that is:

- Harassing, bullying, threatening, or abusive
- Hateful, discriminatory, or demeaning
- Sexually explicit, exploitative, or inappropriate
- Violent, graphic, or encouraging harm

- Illegal or encouraging illegal activity
- Spam, scams, impersonation, or deceptive behavior
- Invasive of someone's privacy
- Otherwise unsafe, offensive, or objectionable

You may not use Desso to abuse, harass, threaten, stalk, exploit, or intimidate another person.

If we determine that content or behavior violates these rules, we may remove the content, limit access to features, suspend the account, ban the user, or take other action.

4. FILTERING OBJECTIONABLE CONTENT

Desso may use automated, manual, or system-level filtering to help prevent objectionable content from being posted or shown in the app.

This may include filtering text, images, profiles, messages, reports, or other user-generated content.

Filtering is not perfect, and some objectionable content may still appear. Users are encouraged to report any content or behavior that violates these rules.

5. REPORTING OBJECTIONABLE CONTENT

Users can report objectionable content, profiles, or behavior from inside the app.

When a report is submitted, Desso may collect information needed to review the issue, including the reported content, the reported user, the reporting user, timestamps, and relevant context.

Desso reviews reports of objectionable content within 24 hours.

If reported content violates these rules, we may remove the content and suspend, ban, or remove the user who provided the offending content.

6. BLOCKING ABUSIVE USERS

Users can block abusive or unwanted users from inside the app.

When you block a user:

- That user's content will be removed from your feed immediately.
- You will no longer see that user in relevant parts of the app.
- The blocked user will be restricted from interacting with you where applicable.
- Desso will be notified so we can review the situation for safety and moderation purposes.

Blocking is intended to give users immediate control over their experience. Desso may also take additional action against blocked users if their content or behavior violates these Terms.

7. USER CONTENT

You are responsible for the content you provide through Desso, including profile information, photos, messages, reports, and other content.

You agree that you have the right to share anything you upload or submit.

You grant Desso permission to store, display, process, and use your content as needed to operate, improve, moderate, and provide the app.

You understand that other users may see the content you choose to make visible in the app.

Do not share private, sensitive, illegal, or harmful content.

8. ACCOUNT SAFETY

You are responsible for keeping your account secure.

- Do not share your login credentials.
- Do not use another person's account.

We may suspend or remove accounts that appear fraudulent, fake, automated, abusive, or unsafe.

9. PRIVACY POLICY

This section explains what information Desso collects, how we use it, and how users can contact us about privacy.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Depending on how you use Desso, we may collect:

- Account information, such as your phone number, email address, login credentials, and user ID.
- Profile information, such as your name, age, photos, bio, preferences, and other information you choose to provide.
- Location information, such as your approximate or precise location if you grant location permission.
- User content, such as posts, profile content, messages, likes, reports, blocks, and other interactions.
- Safety and moderation information, such as reports, blocked users, moderation decisions, and content review records.
- Device and technical information, such as device type, app version, operating system, IP address, logs, crash data, and diagnostic information.
- Usage information, such as app interactions, screens viewed, features used, timestamps, and general activity.

HOW WE USE INFORMATION

We use information to:

- Create and manage user accounts.
- Provide the app's core features.
- Show relevant users, profiles, content, or nearby activity.
- Enable user interactions.
- Improve app performance and reliability.
- Prevent spam, abuse, fraud, and unsafe behavior.
- Filter and moderate objectionable content.
- Review reports and blocks.
- Enforce these Terms and Community Guidelines.
- Respond to support, safety, legal, or privacy requests.
- Maintain security and comply with applicable law.

LOCATION INFORMATION

Desso may use location information to help users discover and connect with people nearby.

You can control location permissions through your device settings. Some features may not work properly if location access is disabled.

Do not use Desso in a way that exposes another person's private location without their consent.

SHARING INFORMATION

We do not sell your personal information.

We may share information in limited situations, including:

- With service providers that help us operate the app, such as hosting, authentication, messaging, analytics, storage, crash reporting, or moderation tools.
- When needed to investigate abuse, safety issues, reports, or violations of these Terms.
- If required by law, legal process, or a valid request from authorities.
- To protect the rights, safety, and security of Desso, our users, or others.
- In connection with a business transfer, such as a merger, acquisition, financing, or sale of assets.

Service providers may process information only as needed to provide services to Desso.

DATA RETENTION

We keep information for as long as needed to provide the app, maintain safety, resolve disputes, enforce our rules, comply with law, and operate our business.

We may retain moderation, report, block, and safety records even after content is removed or an account is deleted where needed to protect users and prevent abuse.

ACCOUNT DELETION AND PRIVACY REQUESTS

You may request account deletion or send a privacy request by contacting:

After account deletion, some information may be deleted, de-identified, or retained where necessary for safety, security, legal compliance, fraud prevention, dispute resolution, or enforcement of these Terms.

CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

Desso is not intended for users under 18.

We do not knowingly allow users under 18 to create accounts. If we learn that a user is under 18, we may remove the account.

SECURITY

We use reasonable technical and organizational measures to protect user information.

No system is perfectly secure, and we cannot guarantee that information will always remain secure.

10. COMMUNITY GUIDELINES

BE RESPECTFUL

Treat other users with respect. Do not harass, insult, threaten, shame, stalk, or intimidate others.

BE AUTHENTIC

Do not impersonate another person, create fake accounts, misrepresent yourself, or use misleading profile information.

KEEP CONTENT APPROPRIATE

Do not post sexual, violent, hateful, exploitative, illegal, or otherwise objectionable content.

RESPECT PRIVACY

Do not post or share another person's private information without permission. This includes addresses, phone numbers, private photos, private messages, or precise location information.

DO NOT SPAM OR SCAM

Do not use Desso for spam, scams, phishing, advertising, bots, automation, or deceptive activity.

USE REPORTING AND BLOCKING TOOLS

If you see objectionable content or abusive behavior, report it. If another user makes you uncomfortable, block them.

Desso reviews reports and may remove content or users that violate these guidelines.

11. ENFORCEMENT

Desso may enforce these Terms at our discretion.

Enforcement actions may include:

- Removing content
- Hiding content from feeds
- Warning users
- Limiting features
- Suspending accounts
- Banning users
- Removing users from the service
- Keeping safety records to prevent repeat abuse

We may act without prior notice when needed to protect users, the app, or the community.

12. CHANGES TO THESE TERMS

We may update these Terms, Privacy Policy, and Community Guidelines from time to time.

If we make changes, we may notify users in the app or by other reasonable means.

Your continued use of Desso after changes means you accept the updated terms.
