

## What to Bring to Camp - Counselors

Bring *only what will fit into a duffel bag or one suitcase and a backpack. You will be moving during the summer and will need to carry your belongings. There is no storage space at camp.* Please remember that you are a role model and how you dress is very important. Make sure your clothing is clean and presentable, and has no offensive words, pictures, alcohol or cigarette advertising or any "double meaning" words or phrases on them. You will be expected to swim with your campers during the week so bring appropriate swim attire with you to camp. All camp clothes will be exposed to the elements and children - don't pack your nicest clothes! Please dress appropriately for working with kids, what we wear should reflect what is appropriate for them to wear.

### Personal:

- Sleeping Bag, extra bedding if you'd like
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Extra Pillowcase
- Clothes for warm weather - t-shirts, shorts, light jacket - *Bring about a week and a half's worth of clothes, all comfortable for outdoor activities*
- Clothes for cool weather - long sleeves, hoodie/crewneck, pants, warm socks
- One set of nicer clothes - slacks/dress pants/maxi skirt and dress top
- One set of working clothes - comfortable with getting paint/dirt on
- Shower toiletries and towel
- Closed-toed shoes - comfortable for hiking and day to day wear
- Sandals or flip flops (Shower shoes)
- Appropriate swimsuit & beach towel
- Water bottle
- All toiletries
- Medications
- Spending money and money for laundromats
- Bag for dirty laundry
- Laundry supplies - detergent & dryer sheets/ball
- Extra car key - if bringing vehicle

### For camp:

- Bible
- 1.5 to 2 inch 3-ring binder for staff manual
- Extra notebook for notes/planning
- Writing materials (pens, pencils, highlighters)
- Backpack, large enough to fit binder, first aid supplies, water bottle, etc.

### Misc/Optional:

- Hat
- White t-shirt for tie-dye
