Record a show or series

• Record from the guide, the browsing carousel, or a device.

Schedule an upcoming recording now. It won't show in your playlist until it's done recording.

Want to record a show or movie to watch later? You can:

- Schedule a recording on any device and watch it on another.
- Record multiple shows at the same time until you use all your storage hours.
- Store titles for up to 9 months with DIRECTV STREAM. You'll see an alert 7 days before a recording expires.
- For TV series recordings:

Customers with 20 hours of Cloud DVR storage are allowed a maximum of 10 episodes per TV series. Customers with Unlimited Cloud DVR storage are allowed a maximum of 30 episodes per TV series.

- Once the maximum episode limit is met, the oldest recorded episode will be automatically deleted first (within 9
- months or less) to make room for the next recorded episode.

3. Once recording completes, the title is added to your DVR Playlist. Press LIST to access.

1. Press the **overflow button** (...) on your DIRECTV STREAM remote to record.

2. Select the show you want to watch. Choose **REC.** (If you're using an Android® device, select the 3 dots first.)
