Ginger's Closet & Disaster Relief is proud to announce the Ginger Haberman Memorial Scholarship, created to support West End students entering their second year or later of higher education.

Ginger Haberman was one of the founders of the Disaster Relief Committee and the Clothing Bank, renamed in her honor to Ginger's Closet & Disaster Relief. She was a lifelong advocate for community service. After graduating from Providence Hospital in 1958 as a nurse, she dedicated her career to caring for others. She settled in Forks in 1962 and devoted countless hours to volunteering for local organizations. This scholarship is a tribute to her legacy of giving and community support.

Each year, we will award scholarships to students from the West End who demonstrate financial need, community involvement, and a commitment to their education. This year's scholarships are made possible thanks to all the community members who donated to and volunteered at the Ginger's Fashion Show last year.

# **Scholarship Details**

Award Amount: \$2,000 per recipient (2 awards available)

Application Opens: March 31st

• Application Deadline: May 31st

• Award Notification: June 16th

Funds will be disbursed directly to the recipient's educational institution for tuition and books only.

# **Eligibility Criteria**

To qualify for the Ginger Haberman Memorial Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Residency: Must be a resident of the West End of Washington state (Forks and surrounding areas west of Port Angeles, including the Hoh, Makah, Quileute, and Quinault tribal communities).
- 2. Academic Status: Must be entering their second year or later at an accredited college, university, or trade school.
- 3. Community Involvement: Must demonstrate a commitment to community service, aligning with the values of Ginger's Closet.
- 4. Financial Need: Must provide evidence of financial need.

## **Application Requirements**

Applicants must submit the following materials:

- 1. Completed Application Form Including Financial Statement (see next page)
- 2. Proof of Residency (e.g., ID, utility bill, or school enrollment from a West End institution)
- 3. School Transcript (verifying enrollment in second year or later)
- 4. Personal Statement (500-700 words) addressing:
  - Educational goals and aspirations
  - Community involvement and how it aligns with Ginger's Closet's mission
  - How this scholarship will assist in achieving academic goals
- 5. Two Letters of Recommendation (preferably from educators, mentors, or community leaders)
