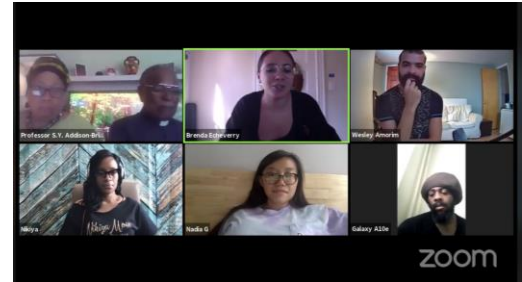

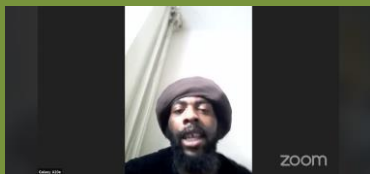

Topic: *Father E.D. Smith, the 'Man' his 'Vision & Forward looking; what's next?*

The Takeaway from the Panel...

"Christ is the wisdom and power of God! We understood because of Father Smith... that you have to take a look at what we were given as Easter or Resurrection Sunday...when the phenomenal happened, when the stone was rolled away and the women encountered what they encountered; my teaching has been that it was not a man but it was the spirit in the upper reception of consciousness that gave them direction to give to others...at that change, there was no more [the] man Jesus Christ. Then it was Christ Jesus... that was the greater thing... that was the comforter. [W]e have fallen back into a dependency on a man...we are not talking about the essence of us as individuals. There was the first Man Adam, Jesus Christ the second Man Adam... do you realize that you and I are the third Man Adam?"

"What I found that was most unique about E.D. Sunlight doesn't fade.*



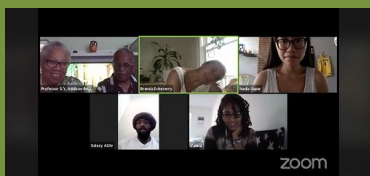

"In my studies of mental health, education and psychology I see a lot of how the history of these systems supposedly wonderful beautiful helpful things that are to heal and help our communities are just coming from a very privileged white male wealthy viewpoint which is very harmful because it is just perpetuating capitalism and the idea of power and continued wealth. Even as we educate our young people the kind of content we offer them, the way we chose to share these ideas with them, the people that they see teaching them, in their textbooks and media are a huge influence on their future actions and how they see themselves. So really I think about education and how will we prepare our youth to lead and challenge authority; and challenge the things that are taught to them even when it is possibly from a very loving traditional standpoint from church, family, and school. "We look at the world we are in right now and we are more connected than ever. The Rev. Michael [Bernard Beckwith] has said that for a while we had with the technology and the information age this expression where suddenly everyone is connected... all corners of the earth. And yet from that people are still utilizing those connections to sow division and separation and otherness. They are using it in a way that they could never use it before. However, that's not just what's happening, there has also been created the global heart. People are expanding their compassion beyond the borders of what they previously experienced and explored. ...I really believe we are emerging into a world where every concept or idea, identity that is utilized to separate us is falling away. Even ideas that people excepted as being absolute like gender...the construct of gender is still man made because we added things to it other than simply that there were two beings created. So many other layers placed on what a woman is and what a man is... and there were always men who didn't fulfill that definition and there were always women who didn't fulfill that definition. The limited idea of what is possible is falling away so that what we see and know of ourselves is our divinity... I see a world that works for everyone." ---Rev.
