Tournament Format:

Four team pools that will conclude on Friday evening. Saturday morning will consist of play-in matches. After the play-in matches, all teams will move on to a single-elimination playoff bracket. All matches are 2 out of 3, with the first two games to 25 and the third game to 15. No point cap on any game.
