"Meet God on the Journey" Luke 24:13-35

Here is a beautiful picture from my pilgrimage on the Camino De Santiago. It was taken September 22, 2019 at



11:13 a.m. In about two and half hours I have only covered about 5 kilometers (3.1 miles) of the 20.7 km (12.9 miles) I had to cover that day. The way had been predominantly a twisty very steep incline crossing over small backroads. During the ascent of the mountain, there was a sudden

driving rain storm with wind, thunder, lightning, the whole bit. I will admit to taking refuge for a while in a small coffee shop conveniently located on the side of a mountain just off a one-lane paved road with some of my fellow pilgrims! In this picture, four fellow pilgrims, all from Spain, are in front of me. They were very friendly (like many Spaniards) and, using my phone, took my picture. We are seen approaching the Embalse de Salime Reservoir, near the small city of Grandas de Salime. Part of the majestic Cantabrian Mountains lie beyond. As I walked I thought about how many pilgrims over the many centuries walked this well-worn path beneath my feet and what they talked about as they covered kilometer after kilometer. How many friendships were made and broken on this pilgrimage? Only God knows!

Then I thought about Emmaus.

Walking with someone for a long distance, or, for a long time, is a sure and certain way of getting to know someone. Some folks might share a life story, or a few thoughts that reveal a type of personality. Some like to tell jokes, or make witty statements. Some are only curious about YOU, and seem hesitant to share much about life. But given enough

miles and time, that often changes. I think the miles wear down your resistance. Boundaries soften. People on the journey with you realize we all have much more in common than not. Trust develops. Friendships grow. Stories are told. Experiences on the journey are shared and celebrated. It was no different for the two travelers to Emmaus.

In the world of medieval pilgrimage tradition and lore, not only are the two travelers to Emmaus considered pilgrims, but Jesus, who joined up with them, is as well. The example is that not only do we have each other's companionship on this journey through life, but also the companionship of God! Often, like the travelers to Emmaus, we don't even know God is along on the journey! There are many paintings and stone relief carvings in Spain depicting Jesus with the travelers on the road to Emmaus. How important is it to you, the thought that Jesus travels with you on your pilgrimage through life?

It has been my pleasure these past four months to get to know the people of Wickliffe Presbyterian Church. You are not difficult to get to know! Everyone was authentic and friendly and helpful. Thank you for welcoming me. When I "signed on" my terms of service were for May-August as a transitional minister. On August 31, those terms will be complete. We have been on an all-to-brief journey together, with each other, and with God. I like to think of it as a pilgrimage, for we have journeyed together, seeking God. I have enjoyed the companionship and I hope you have too! Now it is time for Jules and I to head west to the four corners area (Arizona, New Mexico, Colorado, Utah) and explore some of the ancient indigenous people's relics, such as petroglyphs and cliff dwellings. Please keep us in your prayers and we will keep you in our prayers as well.




