Out of the mouths of the young and old, Out of the mouths of the bold and broken, Out of the mouths of a generation hungry for something real.

Let us proclaim the goodness of God. Let us declare His mercy endures forever. Let us speak His promises over our families, our communities, and ourselves.

Because when God puts a word in your heart, it's not meant to stay there. It's meant to be spoken.

So speak — child of God. Speak boldly. Speak faithfully.

**Blessed is** the mother who taught her child to pray, for she will share God's kingdom.


**Blessed is** the mother who simply answers the startling questions, for she shall always be trusted.
