~A Word from the Minister~

"The Invitation"

I found this used by a 12th Century church in Boldre, Hampshire, England. It is an invitation to visitors, which is how many of us start out with a church (unless we are born and baptized there). Invitations and greetings are important to newcomers, especially if we ever want them to visit again. It also shows how visitors are greeted or invited has been a concern since the beginning of the Church. With just a few changes in language, here it is:

Friend, you enter this church not as a stranger but as a Guest of God. He is your heavenly Father. Come, then, with joy in your heart and thanks on your lips into God's presence, offering God your love and service. Be grateful to the strong and loyal ones who in the name of Jesus Christ built this place of worship and to all who have beautified it and made it holy with their prayers and praises. Ask God's blessing on those who love this home of faith as the inspiration of their labor, rejoicing in the power of the Holy Spirit, and may that blessing rest on you, both now and forever more.

I would not say this is a perfect invitation but it's a good example of how it can be done. Do we have an invitation easily seen and read as visitors enter the church? What does it say? Is it truly welcoming, inviting people to come as they are into God's presence?

Church consultant and author Kennon Callahan says that when people come to church they are looking to hear about three things: help, hope, and home. How can I get *help* with this problem in my life? What *hope* do I have for the future? Where do I belong? Where is my *home*? The more we clearly answer these questions, the more effective we will be in promoting the gospel (according to Callahan).

Summer is the season most often when folks go "church shopping." Summer is a great time to invite a friend/neighbor/acquaintance to worship (and then maybe, go for brunch!). The easy going days of Summer are also the time when a church is most likely to get the highest frequency of visitors. What first impression do we make? What impression should we make? Do we give help? Do we offer a reason for hope? Do we make it feel like home?

Why don't you try your hand at writing an invitation suitable for visitors. What would it say? If you come up with something, I'd like to see it! What are your thoughts?


