PARKING POLICY

To ensure that you, as a tenant, will always have a place to park when you arrive home, this parking policy will take effect immediately and will be strictly enforced. At most two (2) parking permits will be issued per unit and must be clearly displayed in your vehicle at all times.

Terms of Parking Policy

- All vehicles must have current registration and license plates.
- Each unit will be assigned a maximum of two (2) specific parking spaces.
- Parking permits will be issued and must be clearly displayed at all times.
- Do not park in the designated handicapped parking space without the proper permit.
- No parking on any areas that are not designated specifically for parking. (No parking on the lawn, common areas, side of the driveway or parking lot. No double parking)
- Guests may park on the parking pad on the far left of the common area.
- Anyone including tenants or guests, who parks in someone's assigned space will be towed at their own expense.
- Inoperable vehicles are prohibited in the parking areas and must be removed or repaired within five (5) days or towing will be enforced.
- Unauthorized vehicles parked on the premises will be towed at owner's expense.
