**Rules for the Hampstead Civic Club
Amateur BBQ Competition**

1. The BBQ competition includes Pulled Pork, Brisket and one side dish.
2. All participants are required to register for the competition and pay the \$60.00 registration fee by the June 10th.
3. The registration fee includes a Pork Butt, a Brisket Flat and a welcome kit. An additional Pork Butt or Brisket are available for purchase. All meat used must be provided by the Civic Club.
4. Meat will be provided the week of the competition. All pre-smoking preparation may be performed at each participants residence.
5. Each participant will be allocated a 10'x12' area located to the right of the stage where they will smoke their meat. All meat smoking must be performed at the town field.
6. Participants are allowed to set up at 6 PM the Friday night prior to the competition. Participants are allowed to start smoking their meat after set up, however no participant may leave hot coals unattended or open flames unattended.
7. Participants are required to hand in their meat and side for judging between 4:30 and 5:00 in the provided containers to include a judges blind meat box and tray with residual pulled pork.
8. Remainder of pulled pork will be provided in the provided tray and will be used for the Peoples choice competition.
9. Awards will include Peoples choice award, best pulled pork, Best Brisket, and best all around. The number of places for each award will be determined based on number of contestants.
10. Electric smokers are allowed, however prearrangement's are required with the civic club to ensure enough power is available.
11. Selling meat from your designated smoking area is prohibited
12. All contestants are required to have a fire extinguisher with them while running their smoker.
