## Explore treat of Art and Culture of the Belt and Road countries

Embark on an eye-opening journey to nearly 20 exotic countries and regions at The Belt & Road National Art & Culture Expo, to be held in Asia World-Expo from 23 to 25 September 2022.

The Belt & Road National Art & Culture Expo brings out the finest treasures and national culture of China, Hungary, Kazakhstan, Mongolia, Panama, Philippines, Thailand, Russia, Senegal, South Africa, Tanzania, Turkey, Nigeria, Bangladesh, Iran, Myanmar, Taiwan and Hong Kong.

**China Golden Bridge Group** at the “Belt & Road Art and Culture Forum” together with consuls and exhibitors of various countries share national culture, art and world heritage, as well as new

opportunities of the Belt and Road Initiative.

Cultural performances are plentiful, with Turkish artists performing marbled water paintings, and famous Soth African singer Ms. Lolo, who has taken part in Disney’s Lion King Musical, giving performances and lively African drum workshops.

Exhibition highlights include solving Rebik’s Cube puzzles, invented by a Hungarian professor in 1974, at the Hungarian booth, and travelling through time to appreciate Turkish ceramics and tiles at Turkish booth. Moving to Africa, admire works by South African wildlife photographer. At the booth of Senegal, know as the cultural centre of West Africa, displays exquisite handicrafts and traditional sculptures.

Meanwhile, Tanzania takes your breath away with wild animals at the Great Migration. Mongolian artists illustrate how humans live in harmony with environment

and how tradition blends with modernity while Russian masters showcase inspiring artists jewellery. In Asia, Bangladesh booth displays traditional embroidery craft of flowers, animals, birds and geometric shapes in ethnic styles, while in the Middle East, Iran features Persian rugs.

Chinese ceramics and works of Art as well as fine prints and Chinese paintings are displayed at China booth by **Golden Bridge Art** c/o China Golden Bridge Group and Gerald Ho’s Culture and Art Foundation.

Over 150 renowned Hong Kong artists showcase works of different genres, including contemporary art, oil painting, watercolour, sculpture and installation art at “Awakening Desert: Hong Kong Outstanding Artists Exhibition”, which will demonstrate how Hong Kong transforms itself from a ‘cultural desert’ into a ‘cultural oasis’.
