INFORMATION

- This is an easy program that your Council can do help People with Intellectual Disabilities. 80% of the funds raised go to a qualifying program identified by the local council. The remaining 20% is used for statewide donations such as Special Olympics Connecticut, Columbiettes Campership, etc.
- Drives can be conducted at your Church (with pastor's approval), a sporting event or anywhere your creativity will bring you to the public. Ask a local merchant such as a Package Store, Bank, Pizza Shop, Convenience Stores, Big Box Stores or Supermarkets for permission to have members stand in front of their storefront for a weekend or evening to collect donations for people with intellectual disabilities. The busier the location, the better.
- Simply inform people about the good cause you are raising funds to help, and accept donations. Tootsie Rolls are traditionally provided to donors and other people, but a council can use other fundraising methods.
- This an excellent event for your members to involve their families, their children and wives often yield the best results!
- There is no net cost to the Council, just member time commitment.
