

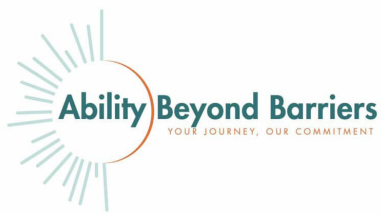

ABILITYWorks is a 15-week workforce education program at Horry-Georgetown Technical College (HGTC) for individuals 18 and older that meet the criteria for intellectual and developmental disabilities who have exited/graduated high school.

ABILITYWorks supports job placement and long-term employment success by preparing individuals for competitive, integrated employment, including opportunities such as internships and registered apprenticeships. Individuals completing the program will earn HGTC Workforce Development Certificates to demonstrate their commitment and growth in workforce readiness skills.

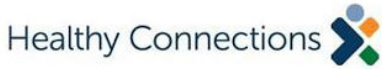
