



DIGNITY HEALTH HOME DELIVERY LAUNCH

Nevada County- Monday April 11, 2022

The Food Bank of Nevada County is now accepting referrals for the Dignity Health Home Delivery Program in partnership with Dignity Health, Sierra Family Health Center, FREED and Connecting Point (211). This program is intended for low-income individuals who have been recently discharged from the hospital and cannot attend food distributions due to a medical condition.

Medical care coordinators may refer clients to this program upon being discharged from the hospital. Discharged clients with a referral may call Connecting Point (211) to sign up for the home delivery program while they recover from their recent hospital visit. Clients should be prepared to answer intake questions.

Clients who have been enrolled will receive a twice monthly delivery from the Food Bank of Nevada County for 60 days during their recovery at no cost to the consumer.
