ABOUT ART DECO

Art Deco is an artistic expression that gained worldwide attention at the 1925 Paris Exposition with the introduction of geometric motifs, fan-shapes, sun rays, ziggurats, zig zag and cubistic designs. As the years progressed into the 1930s and early 1940s, the expression of speed, streamlined and modern forms became popular.

The architecture, music, fashion, interior design, cars and history of the Art Deco Era are so distinctive they are worthy of preservation!
