



NEUROTEST PRIVACY POLICY

This NeuroTest Privacy Policy is to be read in conjunction with the NeuroTest Terms and Conditions of Use and applies only to information collected through the NeuroTest website and SCIT and not to information collected offline.

Registering for SCIT, purchasing of SCIT licenses, and being tested by SCIT will require Users to transmit personal information to NeuroTest Pty Ltd. The transmission of such personal information by any User and NeuroTest Pty Ltd's use and retention of such personal information is governed by the terms of NeuroTest Pty Ltd's Privacy Policy. In the event of an inconsistency between this Agreement and the Privacy Policy, these Terms and Conditions of Use shall prevail.

NeuroTest Pty Ltd is committed to protecting information in accordance with requirements of the Australian Privacy Act. To the extent that the NeuroTest website is accessed by users in other jurisdictions, NeuroTest Pty Ltd cannot guarantee that it complies with relevant privacy legislation in other jurisdictions and Users must make their own enquiries. In agreeing to these Terms and Conditions of Use, Users are also agreeing in full with the terms and procedures laid out in our Privacy Policy.

As you have full control over your data, you may have special obligations to protect the data outside the scope of the protection we provide (for example, if data were downloaded to your local drive or printed). Users are responsible for complying with their obligations under the Privacy Policy and for safeguarding personally identifiable information. Such Users hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless NeuroTest Pty Ltd and its officers, directors and affiliates, from any claim from any User, Parent or governmental or law enforcement agency which arises from a failure of the Parent, Client or Institutional User to adequately safeguard the integrity of any User's data or to adhere to the terms of the Privacy Policy, or these Terms and Conditions of Use.

What information do we collect?

You may visit the NeuroTest website anonymously. We only collect information when a person Registers on the NeuroTest website and when a Participant uses SCIT. The following information is collected and stored in our databases:

- Email address of the person purchasing license(s) ('License Holder')
- License holder's nominated password
- Number of active licenses remaining in a License Holder's account
- A username or code number for each person who is tested ('Participant')
- IP address of the computer device where SCIT was used
- The time, date and results of each completed SCIT test

What do we use your information for?

The information we collect from you may be used in any of the following ways:

- To personalize your experience (your information helps us to better respond to your individual needs)
- To improve customer service (your information helps us to more effectively respond to your customer service requests and support needs)
- To process transactions

Your information, whether public or private, will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or given to any other party for any reason whatsoever, without your consent, other than for the express purpose of delivering the purchased product or service requested.

How do we protect your information?

All information stored in our databases is secured by firewalls and encryption. We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information when you place an order or enter, submit, or access your personal information.

Since purchase of SCIT licenses is managed by an independent, secure payment gateway of a major bank, we do not have access to any of your banking details. All supplied sensitive/credit information is transmitted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology and then encrypted into our Payment gateway provider's database only to be accessible by individuals who are authorized with special access rights to such systems, and they are required to keep the information confidential.

Do we use cookies?

We do not use cookies.

Do we disclose any information to outside parties?

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or servicing you, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or other's rights, property or safety. However, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising or other uses.
