#### Fees for In Person Classes

The Board meet on February 15 and one item of discussion was concerning fees for classes. The board voted unanimously to start charging \$15 per person per class for those classes 4 hours or less. For the classes 4 hours or more the fee will be \$25 per person per class. These fees will help cover the cost of hosting in person classes. All online classes will still be free!

#### **New State Laws**

New state laws have went into affect as of July 1st. One of the biggest changes is **House Bill** 799 which is where the state has adopted the 2018 Energy Code with some of the 2009 Amendments. Make yourself familiar with all newly adopted laws.
