Lunch & Learn August 10, 2025 Scams and Frauds




Officer Keith Bowling of the Largo Police Department will be our guest to speak to us about ways we can protect ourselves from online frauds and scams.

This experiential workshop provides you with presentations and tools to help you move from:


- Being ashamed of not being good enough to releasing fears of who you are and who are your not.
