If payment and roster are not received by the deadline, the invite will pass to the next team in order of inquiry. (Payment and roster will hold your spot. Please submit a copy of your league roster for team entry.)

Tournament Information:

1. Single night round robin pool only. No bracket. Each team will play 3 matches.
2. League team roster players only. No all-star or combined teams.
3. One WIAA official per match.
4. Each match will be 2 sets to 25 and if a 3rd is required to 15. One timeout is allotted per set. Standard substitutions will be allowed following archdiocesan league play. 3 minutes of warm- up per team as soon as previous match ends. If games are ending sooner, the next match will start right away. **Teams 3 and 4, please arrive no later than 5:00pm.** The winner will be decided by win percentage (winning 2/2 vs 2/3 increases percentage), heads up tiebreaker if percentage is the same. Point differential will determine winner if second tie breaker needs to be utilized.
5. First place team will receive medals.
