SHORT RIBS

INGREDIENTS

- 4...... pounds bone-in beef short ribs, well trimmed
- 1...... teaspoon salt, plus additional for seasoning
- 1/2..... teaspoon ground black pepper, plus additional for seasoning
- 1..... tablespoon vegetable oil
- 6..... ounces thick-cut bacon cut into 1/4-inch dice
- 1...... large onion, halved and cut into 1/4-inch slices
- 1..... tablespoon tomato paste
- 2...... tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 2...... tablespoons spicy brown mustard
- 1...... bottle (12 ounces) Irish stout
- 1..... bay leaf
- 1..... cup beef broth
- 2...... tablespoons finely chopped parsley leaves Hot mashed potatoes or cooked egg noodles

INSTRUCTIONS

Season beef with salt and pepper. Heat oil in large skillet over medium-high heat until almost smoking. Working in batches, cook short ribs in skillet, turning to brown on all sides. Transfer each batch to a slow cooker as it is finished. Wipe out pan with paper towels and return to heat.

Cook bacon, stirring occasionally, until crisp, about 4 minutes. Transfer with a slotted spoon to a paper towel-lined plate to drain. Remove and discard all but 1 tablespoon drippings from pan. Reduce heat to medium and add onion. Cook until softened and translucent, stirring occasionally. Add tomato paste, flour, mustard, 1 teaspoon salt and 1/2 teaspoon pepper. Cook, stirring constantly, 1 minute. Remove from bottom of pan. Pour over short ribs. Add drained bacon, bay leaf and beef broth. Cover and cook on low 8 hours, or until meat is tender and falls off the bone.

Remove beef and skim fat from cooking liquid. Remove bay leaf and stir in parsley. Serve with mashed potatoes or egg noodles. Tip: This recipe can be cooked ahead and refrigerated overnight.

The Proverbs Project:

Five Simple Ways to Develop Language in Young Children

Right now, less than a third of DeSoto County's five-year-olds are ready for school. The Proverbs Project is a community initiative designed to spread the word about five simple, fun ways for parents and caregivers to develop language in children ages birth to four. Children with solid language skills and strong vocabularies are more likely to get a better start in school.

The project is based on the research of Dr. Ronald Ferguson from Harvard University, and shares five simple things to do every day with children from birth to age four that will help develop language. The five things are things that most parents do quite naturally, but the key is to do all of these five things purposefully and meaningfully each and every day. The five simple, fun things to do are maximize love, count with your child, talk with your child, play and explore, and read to your child. The Proverbs Project shares detailed information about each of these areas that explains what to do, how to do it, and why it works.

In the following weeks, the Shopper will highlight each one of these five simple things to do. We encourage you to read each short article, to practice the activities suggested, and then share the information with others who could benefit from it. Readers are also encouraged to go to the Proverbs Project website at www.theproverbsproject.org to learn more, and to follow us on Facebook where additional tips and ideas for developing language in our youngest children can be found.




