





Celebrate May as

National Historic Preservation Month

This May, the National Trust for Historic Preservation presents an "entirely virtual" National Historic Preservation Month: "Unlock a Piece of History of Every Day" at https://savingplaces.org/preservationmonth#. XrFtnS2ZOt8. There's still time to join in the fun!

In response to the pandemic, many historic sites are closed to the public, so the Trust is hosting daily virtual tours: "You'll wander the rooms of iconic houses, roam wide-open spaces, and peek behind the scenes at some of your favorite historic sites—all at your own pace."

For example, May 1 featured a tour of the Pope-Leighey House in Alexandria, Virginia, completed in 1940. This National Trust Historic Site "exemplifies Frank Lloyd Wright's Usonian homes, a series of single-story, modestly sized residences that reflect the architect's desire to design an affordable and well-designed home for the average American."

May 16 presents an original play performed at "The Shadows," a National Trust Site in New Iberia, Louisiana. American Playwright Ifa Bayeza wrote a new one-act play entitled "Bunk Johnson—Out of the Shadows: A Blues Poem" that "chronicles Johnson's life in New Iberia and explores his place in music history."

In 1949, President Harry Truman signed into law legislation forming the National Trust for Historic Preservation. The Trust began National Historic Preservation Week in 1973, and it became a month-long observance in 2005.

In Arcadia and DeSoto County, historic preservation provides economic development, live-ability, revitalization, and sustainability. It maintains the unique character of our communities and boosts the pride that residents feel in their neighborhoods.

The DeSoto County Historical Society's John Morgan Ingraham House Museum is also closed to the public. However, the Society is observing National Preservation Month by posting historic photographs and information on the Society's Facebook page and Web site: historicdesoto.org.

In addition, the Society partnered with South Florida State College to make an online, self-guided, mobile-friendly tour of downtown historic Arcadia, Florida. It features maps, historic photos, and brief histories of structures in Arcadia's historic business district. A QR ("Quick Response") Code is posted around town to access the tour or go online at http://libguides.southflorida.edu/florida/desoto_walking_tour.

The Helen C. Washington (HCW) Foundation also features history on its Facebook page. The Foundation—a 501c3, not-for-profit, all-volunteer organization—was founded by Charles Washington (1951-2018) to honor his mother, Helen Copeland Washington (1925-2003), "by establishing a permanent historical record of African-American settlers and their culture in DeSoto County."

An integral part of that "permanent historical record" is the Smith-Brown School, and the Foundation is raising funds to install a Florida Historical Marker at the school's last location. Founded in 1892, under Florida's "separate but equal" segregation laws, the school originally offered only elementary education. In 1921, it became a junior high school, and in 1937-1938, a senior high school with the first class of three graduates.

In 1946, a new building was constructed on Orange Ave. from more than 8,000 cement blocks made by the teachers, students, and parents. After integration, the school was closed in 1970. Hurricane Charley damaged the long-vacant structure in 2004, and it was demolished.


Seven Florida Historical Markers currently identify historic sites in DeSoto County: Arcadia City Hall, Arcadia Historic District (in the Tree of Knowledge Park), DeSoto County (on the courthouse lawn), Fort Ogden (in front of the post office), Owens Community School, Florida Baptist Orphanage (at the southwest corner of N. Arcadia Ave. and W. Winifred St.), and Site of Old Pine Level (9827 NW Pine Level St.).

The Florida Division of Historical Resources notes that its Historical Marker Program is one of its "most popular and visible public history programs. It is designed to raise public awareness of Florida's rich cultural history and to enhance the enjoyment of our historic sites by citizens and tourists." 

FEAR OF CONTRACTING COVID-19 FROM HOSPITALS IS LEADING TO MORE SERIOUS ISSUES

Fear of contracting the COVID-19 virus from hospitals has kept many residents from seeking needed medical care at not only our facility. but hospitals across the nation. In truth, any potential COVID-19 patients are segregated from the rest of the hospital's population and secured in designated negative pressure rooms. The Director of Nursing, Lori A. Colucci of DeSoto Memorial Hospital stated, "All of our staff and our patients are screened upon entry to the facility and required to wear a mask at all times. We also use state of the art equipment to disinfect every area of the hospital. The real fear should be the consequences of delaying care whether that be getting routine lab-work, a mammogram, or going to the Emergency Room."

"Before the Coronavirus started making its way to the United States, we saw approximately 50-60 patients on an average day in our Emergency Room. Currently, we are treating roughly 30 patients per day in the E.R. More people are hesitating to seek treatment and when they finally do gather the courage to go to the hospital, their symptoms are much more severe than if they came initially. Wounds are getting infected, blood sugars are at dangerously high levels, and things that need immediate treatment are having lasting

damage. People are rationalizing their symptoms as something minor so they don't come here and risk catching Coronavirus, when the reality is, they're making themselves worse by staying home." – Amanda Gleockler, Director of DMH Emergency Room.

Jason Newton, Stroke Coordinator for DeSoto Memorial Hospital says, "We went from an average of 15-18 strokes per month; now we are down to 3. When patients do come in, they are usually beyond the treatment window. They've hesitated to seek care out of fear of contracting COVID-19. The treatment window for a stroke is up to 24 hours depending on symptoms that are presented. The majority of our patients are coming in 48-72 hours after onset of symptoms. Patients that arrive within a 4.5 hour window after their symptoms begin can receive a clot busting drug to help alleviate 90% of stroke symptoms if they meet criteria. If a patient presents to the ER within 24 hours and they have a 'large vessel occlusion' they could be eligible for surgical intervention. Beyond that, the treatments are limited to physical, speech, and occupational therapy. In short, the faster you call 911, the better your chances are for reversing permanent disabilities from a stroke. In preparation for our upcoming Primary Stroke

Center Certification, we teach our community "B.E.F.A.S.T." You should check for the following symptoms: B-Balance, E-Eye deviation, F- Facial drooping, A-Arm weakness, S-speech abnormalities, and T-time (don't waste any time seeking treatment)."

The CEO of DMH, Vince Sica added, "The Coronavirus pandemic has been a once in a lifetime event. GARDEN VEGETABLE HUMMUS

- 19-ounce can chickpeas, drained and rinsed (preferably no-salt added)
- 3 to 4 cloves garlic
- 1/2 green bell pepper, cut into chunks
- 1/2 red bell pepper, cut into chunks
- 4 green onions (or 1 medium onion, cut into chunks)
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh basil or Italian parsley
 - tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice (preferably fresh)
- to 3 tablespoons tahini
 Salt and freshly ground black pepper
 Chopped fresh parsley for garnish
- Combine all ingredients except parsley in a food processor fitted with the steel blade. Process
 with quick on/offs to start, then let the motor run until the mixture is very smooth, about 2 minutes,
 scraping down the sides of the bowl as needed.

- 2. Transfer the hummus to a serving bowl and sprinkle with parsley. Cover and chill for 1 to 2 hours before serving. (Hummus will thicken when refrigerated.)
- 3. Note: The tahini in the hummus is a very nutrient-dense ingredient because it has a very low moisture content. It is an excellent source of mono- and polyunsaturated fats, which are good fats, as well as an excellent source of protein, magnesium, zinc, manganese fiber, and potassium. Chickpeas are legumes that are also high in protein and fiber.

As winter gave way to spring, nature did not give any signs in relation to what the people of the world were going through. Some asthma sufferers experience shortness of breath as a result of allergies, so people with asthma should consider that before assuming they have COVID-19. Discussing shortness of breath with a physician can help asthma sufferers gain more clarity on their condition.

While symptoms of allergies and COVID-19 are different, the CDC notes that people suffering from the flu may experience the same symptoms experienced by people with the coronavirus. Symptoms such as fever, fatigue, body aches, and cough can affect both flu and COVID-19 sufferers, so people experiencing these symptoms should contact their physicians.




CHAPTER 10
