WOOD-GRILLED SHRIMP AND YELLOW PEPPERS

- 1/2 cup moistened wood chips or dry wood pellets
- 11/2 pounds large shrimp (18 to 20 count), peeled and deveined
- 30 medium-size spinach leaves
- 2 yellow, red, or orange bell peppers, stemmed, seeded, and cut into quarters
- 1/4 cup olive oil

- Prepare a hot fire on one side of your grill for indirect cooking. 1.
- Wrap each shrimp loosely with a large spinach leaf. Place the shrimp in a disposable aluminum pan. Lightly season with sea salt and pepper, and then drizzle lightly with olive oil.
- For a charcoal grill, throw 1/2 cup moistened wood chips or dry wood pellets directly on the coals 3. right before you want to grill. For a gas grill, enclose the wood chips or pellets in a foil packet with holes poked in the top; place the packet on the grill grate over the heat source.
- When you see the first wisp of smoke from the wood, place the shrimp on the indirect side of the heat and the peppers on the direct side. Close the lid and grill for 8 minutes. 





The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) recently completed the repair and rehabilitation of the fivespan, arch-deck, reinforced concrete bridge (#45001) constructed in 1925 over Peace River. In addition, FDOT "milled and paved" W. Hickory St. from the bridge's east side to Baldwin Ave. In exchange, the City of Arcadia vacated one block of N. Parker Ave. as well as an east-west alley between Baldwin and Parker avenues to consolidate FDOT's property.

So, how did the earliest settlers cross Peace River? Although it probably could be forded in the dry season, assistance was necessary during the rainy season. In his 2002 book, Footprints and Landmarks: Arcadia and DeSoto County, Florida, Howard Melton writes that Captain John Wesley Whidden (1839-1910) and John Kabrich (1854-1928) built a ferry: a flat boat, like a raft, that was pulled across the water by a rope—tied to Whidden's store on the east shore and a tree on the west bank.

On May 19, 1887, the eastern half of Manatee County became DeSoto County, and Pine Level remained the new county's seat of government until voters chose Arcadia in November 1888. Travel from Arcadia to Pine Level included crossing the river. Melton notes that the first bridge was built in 1892 and a second wooden bridge in 1896 by Brown Roberts. A 1907

postcard features that one or a third bridge, perhaps the "iron bridge" constructed by the Converse Bridge Company of Chattanooga, Tennessee. The company built similarly designed bridges in 1914 over the Chipola River and in 1912 over the Steinhatchee River. (The latter, still used by traffic—was named the Bellamy Bridge.) They stand today as some of the State's oldest bridges.



DeSoto County Commissioner Sears Coker (1878-1958) supervised the rebuilding of the iron bridge by Foreman Will F. Garner (1864-1955) in 1919. The Dec. 5 newspaper reported:

"At no time was traffic delayed over fifteen minutes while he was rebuilding the bridge." Earlier repairs did not endure, as noted: "When the old bridge went down under a drove of cattle about two years ago, it was repaired, but the job did not last long."

Garner's crew used heavy-duty materials, such as 8" x 10' yellow pine for "caps" and 6" x 12' heart yellow pine stringers. Durable construction methods were also employed:

"the solid wall protecting the approach is . . . lapped together like the corners of a hewed log house."

On the bridge's east side, runways eased an increase in traffic: "Over these autos glide smoothly, and the jerk resulting from crossing the flooring is absent." The west side's deep sand was vanquished with "a clay approach 100 feet long which makes a rise to the bridge easy for vehicles of all kinds."

The article's headline promised: "Peace River Bridge There For All Time: Remodeled Bridge Over the Peace River Structure That Will Endure." However, three years later, that claim proved false according to the headline in the May 5, 1922, Arcadian: "New Peace River Bridge Advised by Grand Jurors. . . . The condition of the bridge across Peace River is such as to warrant the county commissioners in taking steps for a new one."

Five months later, the Oct. 5 newspaper reported: "The contract for the Peace river bridge was let Saturday afternoon to the Luten Bridge Company of York, Pa., and Palatka, Fla., getting the contract for \$25,000. The work is to begin upon the bridge within the next thirty days and is to be completed within 180 working days." The bridge was finished in June 1925.

The Luten Bridge Company was named for Daniel Benjamin Luten (1869-1946) who graduated from the University of Michigan in





1894 and then was appointed an instructor of civil engineering there. After a year, he resigned to work as an instructor at Purdue University. In 1900, he resigned from teaching to practice engineering. He focused on drawing plans for—and constructing—reinforced concrete bridges. Five years later, he concentrated on planning only. During his 23 years of experience, he designed 20,000 bridges, and the one in Arcadia is probably one of them (http://www4. lib.purdue.edu/archon/?p=collections/findingaid&id=59&q=&rootcontentid=8598).

As soon as the "new concrete bridge was put into service," the old iron bridge had been "closed to traffic," according to the Sept. 22, 1927, Arcadian. That week, "a crew of county convicts [worked] at removing the old iron bridge over Peace River. This eyesore will soon be a thing of the past as the workmen seem to be making a thorough job of cleaning away the debris."



The Lions Club had emphasized the need for bridge lighting to the City Council as reported in the June 21, 1928, Arcadian: "The electric lights on Peace River bridge are now doing their duty, having been turned on for the first time on Tuesday evening. They help the appearance of the west approach to the city even more than had been anticipated. . . . W. W. Pohlman [(1870-1934)], electrician, did the work of installing the lights."

To cut expenses during the Great Depression, the City Council voted to turn off street lights throughout the City—and on the bridge. (Florida Power and Light continued to provide electricity to the lights and did not require the City to pay the bill—but that's another story.) Melton noted that the bridge lights were "short-lived because of persistent vandalism."

The bridge was the City's western entrance until 1961, when the State Road 70 was



reconfigured. The State deeded the old "alignment" to the City, but retained ownership of the bridge. So FDOT funded the recent repair and rehabilitation of the Luten bridge. At 201 feet long, it is the largest bridge construction by the company that remains in the state, according to Historic Highway Bridges of Florida, published by FDOT in 2004.

The new State Road 70 bridges were named in honor of General S. Chesterfield Smith (1895-1969) who served in the Florida National Guard during the Mexican conflict as well as in World Wars I and II, as Arcadia's mayor 1947-1951 and State representative 1951-1967.

The 1925 bridge was closed to vehicular traffic in 1985, and it was designated as the connector between the paved trails in Veterans Memorial Park and Morgan Park in 2012.


