The DeSoto County basketball team stormed their way past the Tenoroc Titans to claim the district championship with a 72-67 win. It is the first district championship for the program since 2007 when current Head Coach Darrel Nicklow was an assistant on the team to Kip Rhoten.

Rhoten's Port Charlotte team also won their district championship on the same night as Nicklow and the Bulldogs. In the Desoto win over the Pirates Rhoten

gathered the Bulldogs together and told them that if they played like they did against his team then they would win the district championship- and they did.

The game started poorly for Desoto as a couple of turnovers put the Titans on top 6-0. DeSoto came back to take a 7-6 lead on Keimar Richardson's steal and layup. Richardson put the final touches on an 8 point period with another layup with 3 seconds left as the Bulldogs took a 20-15 lead at the end of one.

Desoto built a ten point lead in the second period to watch it melt to just 5 points before Richardson scored the final bucket of the half

points with both Richardson and Gilchrist adding 14 each. Mari Redding just missed making it 5 Bulldogs in double figures with 8 points.




Freshman Mari Redding with 10 points and sophomore Nazir "Speedy" Gilchrist with a game high 21 points give the Desoto basketball program a bright future.



- 1. Cook bacon over medium heat until crispy. Drain on a paper towel.
- 2. Select the 24 most uniform tomato slices and save the rest for tomorrowÕs lunch. Dredge slices in flour, then in eggs, then pat down in bread crumbs. Reserve on plates, but do not stack.
- 3. In a sautŽ pan over medium-high heat, add 3 tablespoons oil. When oil is hot, add as many breaded tomato slices as the pan can accommodate without them touching. Fry for approximately 2 minutes per side, or until browned and crispy. Remove from pan and drain on paper towels. Add more oil if necessary for subsequent batches.
- 4. To assemble, line up 12 fried tomato slices. Season with salt and pepper, then top each with 1 cheese slice, a mound of bacon shrapnel and 2 arugula leaves. Cover with a second fried tomato slice. Secure with a toothpick. Let cool for a minute before serving. (Tomatoes have a surprising ability to hold the heat.)


